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## Information & Directions

Hello everyone interested in our REDNECK RIDES!! Welcome to the Redneck SPRING Ride. This year we are adding the spring venue with both 25 & 50 mile rides! We thought, why not, a spring ride so we can move the location and open it up for more riders! As many of you know our Fall location is limited to 35 riders, this venue we can open up so more can come have fun together!

We are located in the foothills near Mt. Lassen, close to Redding and Red Bluff. This trail is very scenic and we will have the wonderful Gore/Baylor Photographers for your trail photos. Many of our trails will be similar to our Fall ride but we are moving location so some trails will be rearranged and extended. Our new base camp location is not super frilly so be prepared to take care of you & your horse. We will have water, porta potties, & food and nicely marked trails. Our camp is located on an old air strip and has a great base of rock so no one should get stuck if we have inclement weather. However, that said we will be in the open & on rocky ground. Speaking of rock... remember we are near a Volcano so there is rock on trails & roads so prep your horse however you deem fit for these kind of riding conditions.

Both nights will be lots of fun with Bon Fires after ride meetings. Relax & enjoy sitting around the campfire with your favorite drink and visiting with other folks.

This is a ride for people who want to relax and have an old fashioned good time! If you are feeling pressure to compete heavily, you may want another venue.

### WE LOOK FORWARD TO SHARING GOOD TIMES WITH YOU ALL!!

**Directions:** Ride camp is off Airport Way in Shingletown. The airstrip is dead ends on Airport Rd. Go straight at the "Y" and thru the big yellow gate. For those who have been here before, this is just BEFORE you turn left onto Emigrant Trail. Go straight at the corner thru the gate and onto the "Strip".

**From Susanville:** Take Hwy 36 through Susanville to the Hwy 44 turn off about 5 miles west of town. Follow Hwy 44 to T intersection with Hwy 89. Turn left and follow the signs to Redding. Stay on 44 for about 27 miles to Shingletown. The turn-off is **Airport road:** It is to the north (right) and is across from KOA campground. Follow Airport road for ½ mile and go straight at the "Y" on to the "Strip".

**From Redding:** Get onto Hwy 44 East and go through Shingletown, and continue another 4.3 miles (or so). Turn north (left) onto **Airport road.** It is across from KOA campground. Follow Airport road for ½ mile and go straight at the "Y" on to the "Strip".
