

**CHAMBERLAIN CREEK 30/50  
SEPTEMBER 28, 2019**

Management and Volunteers would like to invite you to join them for the Chamberlain Creek Endurance Rides.

We expect the trail to be the same stellar course as in past years. The majority of the ride is in the beautiful Jackson Demonstration State Forest and you will be riding in the coastal mountains, which include great views, challenging climbs, and tall coastal Redwood and Fir trees. Most of the footing is good, with short sections of rock. If you plan to ride fast consider padding. There is plenty of hay and water at the vet checks. There will be water at camp for horses. Management will provide water on the trail where it will be most useful. Mornings and evenings could be cool and possibly quite foggy.

**Campsite is limited for space, especially for large rigs, so carpool if possible, please.  
If you need to arrive before Friday September 27, 2019 please contact Marianne (707-272-4121) to make special arrangements.**

Jackson Demonstration State Forest is the major property we will be using. Other properties we cross will be, Mendocino Redwood Co. LLC, and Conservation Fund property, respectively.

**LOCATION:** Camp is approximately 16 miles west of Highway 101 between Willits and Fort Bragg on Highway 20 or 17 miles east of Fort Bragg on Highway 20. Camp will be marked with ribbons. This camp is adjacent to Highway 20, so if you plan on bringing pets, they must be on leash. Small children must have adequate supervision.

**RIDE RULES:** The Chamberlain Creek Rides will comply with all AERC ride rules. Ride management reserves the right to interpret and enforce the rules and to settle any questions, which may arise from or be in connection with, any incidents that may occur at the ride.
