PAVED ROAD IN FOR THOSE COMING FROM THE SOUTH!
THERE IS A STORE FOR LAST MINUTE ITEMS AND CAMPFIRE AT FIRE PIT ONLY

The Gold Rush Shuffle rides will be located at horse campgrounds at the North Shore Entrance of Camp Far West Lake near Wheatland, CA. From Wheatland turn East off Hwy 65 on to Main Street this will become Spenceville Road go approx 5.5 miles turn right onto Camp Far West Road winds thru houses (approx. 2.5 mi) then before bridge/ dam turn left and follow ribbons to North Shore Camp Far West Lake Entrance at the big blue gates. Follow paved road to store and check in and pay camping fees directly to the store (credit card or cash only - \$13/day per rig). This way will be marked & flagged from Wheatland to camp. (Camp Address: 8176 Camp Far West Road, Wheatland, Ca 95692)

To avoid 5 miles of dirt/rutted road - RECOMMENDED from Hiway 20 for Large Rigs

From Hwy 20 take Hammonton/Smartsville Road (across from Forestry Fire Station) at Chuck Yeager Road continue on Hammonton/Smartsville Road for approx 13.2 miles to Griffith Ave. turn LEFT go 1.6 mi to Erle Road turn RIGHT go approx 1.7 miles to Hwy go SOUTH & take 65 to Wheatland see above directions.

For those who know the area and have been to the Old Camp site this is rough on big rigs (5 miles of very bad road)

Take Chuck Yeager Road take that south to Waldo Road follow this to Spenceville Road after bridge stay RIGHT about 5 miles to Camp entrance located at the North Shore Camp Far West Lake. You will drive over the paved steep hills to get here. Entrance is on the left. Follow paved road to store and check in and pay camping fees directly to the store.

This ride offers the perfect trail for those of you who like to go fast as well as those who have a horse that is not yet in great condition and is a great first time ride. The terrain is fairly flat with some rolling hills and good footing, with few rocky areas. You will ride mostly over trail, partly on dirt roads, with a little cross-country. There is plenty of natural water on the trail. The trail consists of various loops in the Spenceville Wildlife area and lake trails. All checks are in camp. THERE WILL BE NEW TRAILS USED WITH LAKE VIEWS AND LAKE TRAIL to offer some variety to those riding all three days.

Pre-Ride Vet Checks: Start on Thursday, November 28 approx 2:00 pm till 5:00 pm. For those riding multi days your post Vet Ck is your pre-ride ck for the next day. A pre-ride meeting will be held at 7:00 pm, each day. Starting Time: The ride will start at 6:30 am for the 55 & 50 mile rides and 7:30 am for the 30 mile rides so that everyone has a chance to be complete by dark and enjoy visiting by the campfire.

RIDE RULES

1. Equines must be at least 60 months for the 55 & 50-mile rides and 48 months for the 30-mile rides
2. Mares in foal will not be permitted.
3. Hoof protection recommended but not required.
4. Riders under 16 years of age on Dec. 1st, in the year of competition must be accompanied by an adult (at least 21 years of age) that has entered the ride and agrees to remain with the minor throughout the ride. Riders under 16 will not be permitted to start or continue on from any point of the ride without the original sponsor, unless the sponsor is pulled and makes arrangements with ride management for the minor to go on with someone else, Juniors must wear helmets.
5. Abuse of the horse or the use of stimulants and/or pain killers is prohibited.
6. All horses are subject to saliva, urine and blood test.
7. No substances of any type may be injected by needle into the horse during the day of the ride.
8. Any horse tested for drugs and found to be POSITIVE will be disqualified.
9. The top-ten horses finishing the ride may be presented for best condition judging.
10. All horses must be presented for pre-ride veterinary inspection between the hours of 2 pm and 5 pm on Thursday, for Friday's ride - no early morning vet-in, all Vet-in must be done day before ride.
11. All riders must stay on the marked trail. Any rider reported off the trail will be disqualified.
12. All veterinary decisions are final.
13. **No refunds** for cancellations past **NOVEMBER 25th** – No refunds for bad weather.
14. There will be no ties.
