Endurance riding is an athletic event for both horse and rider in which the first goal is to complete the marked trails; and the second goal is to ride this trail as rapidly as the condition of horse and rider allows. A qualified veterinarian and ride manager controls each AERC sanctioned ride to a certain extent. All equines must pass the thorough vet checks before and during the event before they are allowed to continue. After the ride, the equine must pass another thorough check before being allowed a completion.

Campsite: Open Range, cross country, roads and trails. Binns Ranch is a family-owned and operated 82 section working cattle ranch.

Trails: The terrain here is, hard surface gravel roads, two-track roads, single trails. Trails will go through cattle pastures, wash crossings. Altitude differentials are 1500m-2700m. All vet checks will be in camp: loop lengths, hold times, and veterinary criteria will be discussed at the pre-ride meeting. For these trails you will need shoes of some kind!!

Intro Riders: The Intro Ride offers an opportunity for newcomers (riders and/or equines) to see what endurance is all about. Intro riders will complete a loop of approximately 10 - 15 miles and have a pre-and post-ride vet check. There is no minimum or maximum time for completion. There are no point or mileage accumulations, no placement awards, no best condition judging, nor are results reported to AERC. However if your horse successfully completes the ride, you will receive a completion award and have had the opportunity to experience the sport of endurance.

Intro Riders are required to have a current, negative coggins.

If you do not plan to camp Friday night, but plan to ride Saturday please attend the Friday Night Pre-Ride Meeting because it will be very beneficial in understanding the sport and outline of the ride.

Directions:

Our base camp is located at the Binns' ranch headquarters (677 Nogal Canyon Rd) off of Hwy 1. Look for signs turning you into camp. Hwy 1 can be accessed from I-25 coming from the north or the south.

** If you are headed north on I-25 from Truth or Consequences you will take exit #100 go over the interstate then turn right onto Hwy 1 north. Make a left hand turn after you go through Nogal Canyon on 677 Nogal Canyon Rd, which will be between mile marker 17 and 18. Drive about 2.5 miles, to ranch house.

** If you are headed south on I-25 from Socorro, NM take exit #115 go over the interstate then turn right onto Hwy 1 south. About 6 miles Make a right (west) hand turn on 677 Nogal Canyon Rd, if you go into Nogal Canyon you went to far, the will be between mile marker 17 and 18. Then drive about 2.5 miles, to ranch house.
