**CAMPING:\*\* MIDWEST TRAIL RIDE.** Reserve campsites through the campground. Camp may fill up so be sure to call Midwest at (812) 834-6686 for your campsite and stall reservations today. **NO ARRIVALS PRIOR TO NOON OR YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR AN EXTRA DAY. SEE CAMP RULES ON LAST PAGE.**

Midwest Trail Ride is a premier horse camp that offers only electric sites or cabins with small stalls, (no primitive sites). Sawdust provided for bedding. Will have a designated area to set up horse pens near the vetting area but no pens allowed near your trailers. Stalls are located directly behind your trailer. Daily camping and stall fees to be paid directly to Midwest Campground. PLEASE NOTE: Coggins are required and out-of-state horses MUST have health certificates, and will be checked upon arrival. Must stop at camp office on the way in to pay. Showers available in bath house.

**FOOD:** **POT LUCK MEAL THURSDAY NIGHT!** Please bring a dish to share. Meal for Friday night is pizza and salad supplied by ride management. If you'd like to bring a dessert to share that would be great. Bring your own drinks. Breakfast sales available on Saturday morning by the Midwest Trail Ride in the mess hall for crew.

**TERRAIN:** The trails in Hoosier National Forest offer a wide variety of terrain and scenery from rolling hills to wide forest trails with some gravel forest roads. Hoof protection recommended. All vet checks will be in camp.

**VET-IN/START:** Vet in begins at 3pm Thursday for Fridays ride and 3pm Friday for Saturdays ride; Ride will begin at dawn both days. HEAD VET: Bob Marshall, DVM, treatment vet Mike Habel, DVM.

**AWARDS:** Completion awards to all who finish meeting ride criteria and following all ride rules. Top 10 awards in the 50 Endurance; Top 10 awards in the 25 Endurance; Top Juniors for both distances. Novice riders will also receive completion awards.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** The forest service may cancel ride up to 24 hours before the event due to inclement weather, including excessive rain or tornado threat. If this were to occur the event would be rescheduled to a later summer date and all deposits on campsites would be honored on the rescheduled date. All other fees will be refunded.

**DIRECTIONS:** **DO NOT USE GPS AS IT MAY TAKE YOU DOWN NARROW GRAVEL ROADS AND NARROW BRIDGES.**  
**From the North** - In Indiana on I-65, exit at Columbus turning West on Hwy 46 toward Bloomington. Then turn South on 446. 7 miles after you pass over Lake Monroe, you'll see a Lawrence County sign on your right, Hunter's Creek Rd is the next street on the left, turn left here and then take an immediate right, camp is about a 1/2 mile on the left.  
**From the South** - In Indiana on I-65 exit at Seymour turning West on Hwy 50. Turn North on Hwy 446, go 8 miles and Hunter's Creek Road will be on the right. Turn right and then take another immediate right, camp is about 1/2 mile on the left.

**ENTRY FEES:** 50 Miles (Friday & Saturday) = \$110\*      \*\*Juniors 50 Miles = \$60\*  
25 Miles (Friday & Saturday) = \$95\*      \*\*Juniors 25 Miles = \$45\*  
10 or 15 Mile Novice Ride (Friday & Saturday) \$45, Juniors \$25, Completion award to all who finish.  
No pre-entry required for Novice ride. No AERC fee for Novice ride.

\* Non-AERC members must add \$15 \*\* Juniors are required to wear helmets.

## Midwest Trail Ride and DBDR Camp Rules

1. Midwest employees have absolute authority & reserve the right to reject any reservation.
2. Everyone must register at the front desk, campers, day riders, guests, everyone.
3. No unauthorized vendors, this means folks selling stuff.
4. Only 4 people or 4 stalls allowed per site, please.
5. **If you check in before NOON, you will pay for an extra night. Check-in Time 12:00pm – Check-Out Time 5:00pm. (MTR has agreed to be more lenient with the endurance ride on the check out times).**
6. One living quarters trailer per site. Site sharing is only permitted if the second trailer is non electrical and not plugged in; and is less than 14' long
7. **Deposits are non-refundable** unless we fill your site with another reservation.
8. Coggins required on all horses and 30-day health papers are required for out-of-state horses.
9. We are not responsible for injury, lost, damaged or stolen property.
10. Slow down when passing riders on the trail, pass all riders with respect and courtesy.
11. Walk on your horses at all times while in camp. No running or trotting allowed.

### STALL CLEANING

**STALLS MUST BE CLEANED PRIOR TO YOUR DEPARTURE OR BE CHARGED \$15.00 PER STALL.**

### DOG POLICY

1. **DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH IN THE CAMPGROUND AT ALL TIMES.**
2. **YOUR DOG IS YOUR LIABILITY. PLEASE CONSIDER WHETHER YOUR DOG IS APPROPRIATE FOR A HORSE CAMPGROUND SITUATION. IF NOT, IT IS IN YOUR BEST INTEREST TO LEAVE IT AT HOME!!** You are responsible for the actions of your dog in camp or on the trail. If your dog bites someone, spooks a horse, or is somehow involved in an injury to a horse or rider, you are liable. Midwest Trail Ride is not responsible for your dog's actions.
3. **IF YOUR DOG BARKS EXCESSIVELY, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE IT FROM THE PREMISES.** This will be enforced so all campers may have a peaceful stay.
4. **CAMPSITES ARE NOT DOGGIE TOILETS. PLEASE PICKUP AFTER YOUR DOG.** Nobody likes to step in doggie dodo. Please be considerate of fellow campers.
5. **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED IN THE STORE OR MESS HALL!**
6. **THE DOG POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. FIRST AND SECOND VIOLATION IS A WARNING. THIRD STRIKE AND YOU'RE OUT WITHOUT A REFUND!**
