

# Nevada Derby

Saturday, April 6, 2019 · 25/50 Miles (Triple Crown Qualifier) ` & Introductory Ride

**CHANGE OF VENUE:** Due to the extreme winter conditions in Washoe Valley, we are forced to move the ride to Red Rock for the safety of our horses and riders...

**CAMP:** The camp is bare bones. There is horse water available, but for the most part, you need to plan on bringing what you need. There will be NO camp fires allowed. Parking is very limited, so if you can trailer-pool, then please do so and plan on parking conservatively. We will provide a Taco Truck to all riders and volunteers. The elevation is over 5000', so come prepared for any type of weather. It is recommended that you leave your dog home. **DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES** (see Ride Rules) Ride camp opens on Thursday, April 4th.

**DIRECTIONS:** Ride camp is located off Red Rock Road, just a little north of Reno. Take the Red Rock exit off us Hwy 395 and head east 15 miles. There will be ribbons and signs telling you where to turn right onto a dirt road. Follow the dirt road about a mile to camp.

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION:** There will be a 50-Mile, a 25-Mile and a 10-Mile Intro ride. All holds Will be in camp, so there is no need for a crew. As there are no vehicles allowed in the ride area, crews will not be able to meet riders out on the trail unless they want to walk. The trail is almost entirely sandy jeep roads and sandy single track. There are hardly any Rocks. There could be a few rocks, so please use some type of foot protection.

**PRE-RIDE VET CHECK / RIDE MEETING:** Our ride control judge will be Dr. Susan McCartney. Vetting will begin upon the arrival of the veterinarians, or 4:00 pm Friday. The ride meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. Any time changes will be posted and/or announced.

**STARTING TIMES:** 50 mile ride begins at 7:00 a.m., 25 mile ride begins at 8:00 a.m. Fun ride begins at 9am.

**MEALS:** We will provide a Taco Truck to all riders and volunteers. It will serve food from 11 a.m until 7 p.m. Riders and volunteers will receive one meal ticket. Use your meal ticket or purchase additional meals with cash.

**AWARDS:** Completion awards to all 25's and 50's will be presented approximately 6pm on Saturday. Additional awards to 1st overall, 1st in each weight division, 1<sup>st</sup> Junior and Top Ten for the 50 mile rides. Best Condition Awards will be presented for the 25 and 50 mile rides. Please pick up your awards if you are not staying for the presentation, as they will not be mailed.

**TRIPLE CROWN:** The Nevada Derby is the first test in our NASTR Triple Crown - three rides, of increasing distance and difficulty, through Northern Nevada valleys, deserts, foothills, and mountains. We invite you to test yourself and your horse, and join us in the fun and challenge, as well as the special awards. Triple Crown Nomination fee is \$15.00 if paid at the time of Nevada Derby, \$20 if paid at the time of NASTR 75, or \$25 if paid at the time of Virginia City 100.

# NASTR Triple Crown

The Nevada Derby 50 Mile Ride is the 1<sup>st</sup> ride of the NASTR Triple Crown. It is put on to help support the Nevada All-State Trail Riders, Inc. Virginia City 100 Mile Ride.

Embroidered jackets will be awarded to all horse and rider teams who finish all three rides (same horse and rider). Halters will be awarded for individual horses and embroidered vests for riders who finish all three rides. Placing will be based on accumulative ride times.

## NV Derby Ride Rules (also see AERC rules and regulations)

1. The rides are sanctioned by A.E.R.C. and will comply with the A.E.R.C. rules and regulations. It is the responsibility of the rider to know the rules and regulations which can be found at [www.aerc.org](http://www.aerc.org)
2. All riders are totally responsible for self, crew, and equine (before, during, and after the ride).
3. Loose dogs may result in rider disqualification. **KEEP YOUR DOGS ON A LEASH OR WITHIN YOUR RIG AT ALL TIMES.**
4. NASTR rides are open to all persons and equines.
5. Riders or their crews, who are in any way rude or insulting to Control Judges, treatment vets, ride management, volunteers, local landowners, or other trail users, will risk disqualification of the rider.
6. A "Junior" is a rider under the age of 16 as of December 1st in the year of competition, and **MUST** be accompanied by a Senior sponsor, at least 18 years old, at all times. A change of sponsor during the ride may not be made unless approved by management. **ALL JUNIOR RIDERS MUST WEAR AN APPROVED SAFETY HELMET.**
7. There shall be no unauthorized horses on the trail.
8. Horses must be at least 48 months old for the 25 miler and 60 months old for the 50 miler, as confirmed by the Ride Control Judge(s).
9. No pregnant or nursing mares will be allowed.
10. The same horse and rider must pass all control points, and stay on the marked trail, in order to qualify for any awards.
11. There will be no ties allowed.
12. The ride must be completed in 6 hours for the 25 miler and 12 hours for the 50 miler (in elapsed time) to qualify for awards.
13. Horses must be shod or have some kind of hoof protection.
14. All matters concerning the horse will be made final by the Head Control Judge.
15. All horses shall be presented for a pre-ride veterinary inspection, between the designated hours of the ride.
16. The same horse and rider must pass all control points and stay on the marked trail to qualify for completion.
17. Riders/horse owners are financially responsible for any emergency veterinary treatment provided.
18. Abuse of the horse and/or use of drugs is prohibited. All horses shall be subject to a blood and urine test.
19. Ride management reserves the right to interpret these rules and regulations as necessary, to insure the continuity of the ride, and will settle any questions or disputes that might arise from any incident that might occur during the ride.
20. Violation of any of these rules shall be grounds for disqualification of horse and rider from the ride.
