Sept 1 – 50 & 25 Miles
Trail Rides both days

Directions: From I-84 in Boise take Hwy 21 NE 36 miles to Idaho City. Turn Left (north) onto Montgomery St. At the end of the street, turn left (west) and continue for 7 miles (dirt road between towns) to Centerville. Turn right (north) onto Henry’s creek Rd. and continue approx. ½ mile into camp.

Camp: Ride camp is located on private property, but borders public land so weed free hay is preferred. Horse water will be supplied but bring people water. **DOGS are always welcome**, but must be leashed at all times. Do NOT bring dogs to registration, vet area, ride meetings or awards dinner. **FIRE** danger is very real this time of year – only one community fire will be allowed, if any.

FEE Schedule: 50 and Limited Distances (25&30) \$100 each distance, each day. Current year/reciprocating ride managers \$50 (one day only; 2nd day at full price). Trail Riders \$20/day. Non-AERC members will be subject to an additional \$15 per day non-member fee.

JUNIORS (under age 18 as of 1/1/19) ride FREE

Starting Times for Both Days: 50 mile riders @6:30am; LDs @ 7:30am. Trail ride any time after 9am but no later than 3pm (trail riders must check in & out with ride management) Check-in and Vetting to start approx. 4pm on Friday Aug 30th for Saturday riders, Pre-vet for Sunday-only riders anytime on Saturday at the discretion of the Vets.

Trails: Trails are primarily old logging roads, ATV and single-track trails on private property, US Forest Service and Idaho State Lands. The terrain is mostly sound footing with sandy surfaces, but there are rocky sections. **Hoof Protection is STRONGLY recommended** for all horses competing.

Meetings: Registration starts approx. 4pm on Friday. Pre-ride meeting at 7pm. Potluck dinners on Saturday and Sunday around 6pm followed by award meetings. Please bring a dish to share.
