

# Torre Creek Ride

Memorial Day Endurance Rides  
May 24<sup>th</sup> (30/55 mile), 25<sup>th</sup> (25/50 mile) & 26<sup>th</sup> (25/50 mile), 2019

AT THE EUREKA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS DIRECTLY OFF HWY 50.

## DIRECTIONS

**From Carson City:** Take Hwy 50 East to Eureka.

**From Reno/Sparks:** Exit Fernley toward Hwy 50 on 50A until it merges with 50.

**From Utah:** Google best directions to Eureka from your location

**Eureka County Fairgrounds has no physical address: Hwy 50, Eureka, NV 89316**  
Entrance will be ribboned from both directions.

Recommend fueling up in Fallon. Next available fuel will be in Austin where prices are typically higher.  
Amenities available in Eureka include: fuel, grocery, hardware, limited feed store, restaurants & hotels

## CAMP

Camping fees for Thursday 5/23- Monday 5/27 are included in ride entry. Each additional day will be \$10 per rig.  
Ample parking available. Can accommodate large rigs. Fairgrounds have amenities which include a pavilion, arena, corrals, horse water & restrooms (sorry, no showers). Bring your own water for human consumption.

Dogs must be kept on leashes at all times but it is recommended that you leave your dog at home since we are near the highway.

\$50 deposit check will be required at check-in which will be returned uncashed pending clean camp check out upon departure. The local 4H kids will likely be present to work for donations helping clean up camp.

## MEALS

Lunch will be provided each day with paid entries. There will be a potluck dinner on Thursday 5/23. Dinner will not be provided any other night so please come prepared.

## TRAIL

Basecamp is at 6500' elevation and we will be riding up to 9500 feet. The trail will be of moderate difficulty with some long deceptive climbs. Pads and/or boots are recommended. The dessert terrain varies from rocky to sandy with sage brush. There are some steep uphill and downhill, water crossings, cow trails, with cross-country and ranch roads. The cows should be on the North end of the ranch but there is a possibility of seeing them out there.

**Pre-Ride Vet Checks:** Start on Thursday, May 23 approx 2:00 pm. For those riding multi days your post Vet Ck is your pre-ride ck for the next day. A pre-ride meeting will be held at **7:00 pm**, each day. **Starting Time:** The ride will start at **7:00 am** for the **55 & 50** mile rides and **8:00 am** for the **30 & 25** mile rides. Our ride vet and control judge will be Dr. Susan McCartney.

**RIDE RULES**

1. Equines must be at least 60 months for the 55 & 50-mile rides and 48 months for the 30 & 25-mile rides
2. Mares in foal will not be permitted.
3. Hoof protection recommended but not required.
4. Riders under 16 years of age on Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>, in the year of competition must be accompanied by an adult (at least 21 years of age) that has entered the ride and agrees to remain with the minor throughout the ride. Riders under 16 will not be permitted to start or continue on from any point of the ride without the original sponsor, unless the sponsor is pulled and makes arrangements with ride management for the minor to go on with someone else, Juniors must wear helmets.
5. Abuse of the horse or the use of stimulants and/or pain killers is prohibited.
6. All horses are subject to saliva, urine and blood test.
7. No substances of any type may be injected by needle into the horse during the day of the ride.
8. Any horse tested for drugs and found to be POSITIVE will be disqualified.
9. The top-ten horses finishing the ride may be presented for best condition judging.
10. All horses must be presented for pre-ride veterinary inspection between the hours of 2 pm and 5 pm on Thursday, for Friday's ride - no early morning vet-in, all Vet-in must be done day before ride.
11. All riders must stay on the marked trail. Any rider reported off the trail will be disqualified.
12. All veterinary decisions are final.
13. **Refunds** for cancellations prior to **MAY 15<sup>th</sup>**. **No refunds for bad weather.** Any equine that does not vet in will receive refund. Refunds subject to \$25 admin fee.
14. There will be no ties.
