DIRECTIONS:

Take Interstate I-44 to exit 129 MO-32/MO-5 toward Hartville. Turn southeast, then immediately turn left at the stop light to follow 32 E. Stay on 32E approximately 15 miles. At K highway, turn left. Follow K highway 4 miles to AC highway. Turn right onto Flagstone Rd (gravel) at the intersection of K and AC. Follow for 1.1 miles. At the "Y" turn left onto Village Rd. Camp will be 0.3 more miles on your right.

CAMPGROUND:

This is a primitive campground. No running water or electricity. Horse water will be provided. There is also a small pond. Space is limited. PLEASE let me know if you cannot make it.

GET TO THE RIDE MANAGER ASAP:

- Pre entry will be required with payment (no PayPal) and a copy of your coggins;
- NO REFUNDS will be given except in the event of ride cancellation.
- Covid-19 guideline Agreement needs to be printed and signed Via snail mail
- Release Form needs to be printed and signed via snail mail

As a participant in the God's Country Endurance Ride (OCER), I agree to abide by the rules of AERC and understand endurance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, away from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas may have natural and man-made hazards which ride management cannot control and identify, modify or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable, and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time. As a condition precedent to my participation in this activity, I agree to take full responsibility for myself, my children, animals and property. I further agree to hold harmless AERC and OCER and their respective officers, directors, members, volunteers, sponsors, participants, and/or premise owners of all properties where the activity(ies) take place (hereinafter collectively referred to as "The Released Parties"), and further agree I will not bring a claim, suit or litigation of any nature against the Released Parties for any damages I suffer, economic or non-economic, which relates in any manner to my participation and/or involvement in this activity, including those instances arising from the alleged negligence of the Released Parties. I further agree that should a claim of any nature arise under this Agreement, said claim shall be submitted to binding arbitration before a neutral arbitrator mutually selected by all parties involved. Venue and law shall be governed by the location where OCER's primary business office is located at the time of the incident.

Covid-19 Guideline Agreement

NO REFUNDS will be given except in the event of ride cancellation.

Please read carefully, initial each bullet point and sign below. This form needs to be mailed with your entry form, copy of current coggins, payment and release form in a timely manner in order to be included in the limited number of 30 rigs. If I don't receive your pre-registration within 7 days of signing up, I will need to move on to the list of other interested riders.

_____ *You will receive a rider packet at the entrance of ride camp that covers each distance's start time, mileage, order and color of loops, heart rate criteria, and hold times. There will not be a ride meeting.

_____ *You will be shown where to park your rig and will need to stay at or around your camp until vetting-in starts at 4:00 Fri June 19.

_____ *The ride manager will be on site at her own rig with a table and sterilizing items available at the entrance for YOU to use before you enter to answer any questions you have.

_____ *Be willing to be considerate of other camp sites and adhere to social distancing standards of not less than 6 feet at all times.

_____ *There will be a scribe with each vet. There will also be a "horse handler". It will be clearly marked where you should stand and wait for your horse to be vetted, and then you will be invited to do your own trot out. Then please hand your horse back over to the "handler" and step back 6 ft. This will be in effect during pre-ride, during the ride, and post ride Vet Checks.

_____ *It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are healthy before attending this endurance event. This includes taking your temperature before you leave home. Do not attend the event if you are showing signs of illness to include, but not limited to, fever, cough, chills, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or loss of sense of smell or taste

_____ *If you do not want to follow any one or more of these guidelines, please do not attend this event, and allow another rider the chance to compete.
