



## LIZARD RUN 25/50

MARCH 14, 2020

LEE STATE PARK; BISHOPVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA

SANCTIONED BY: AERC

**BASE CAMP:** LEE STATE PARK - Nestled in a floodplain forest along the designated state scenic lynches river, conveniently located just off interstate I-20. Primitive camping and vet area will be located at the equestrian show arena. The facility is 7 miles from the town of Bishopville and only 3 miles from I-20. The closest gas/diesel is located off exit 120 (4 miles from the park) There are 22 Equestrian Campsites located on the park with electrical and water hookups; however, these sites are located about 1 mile from the main arena area where vet in & check in will be. There is ample primitive camping space available at the arena, horse water is also available; however the park ranger asks that you bring drinking water for personal use as per DHEC suggested guidelines.

**\*To reserve & pay for full hook up, corrals, or primitive campsites, call the park office at (803)428-5307.**

**\*Primitive camping fees: \$15.80 per night (including tax+fees)**

**TRAILS:** Mixture of sandy flat woods trails, packed dirt roads, 4-wheeler trails, and possible water to ride through depending on weather. Shoes are not required, but recommended for longer distances due to some gravel areas on the loop road section of trail along the river.

### **MEALS:**

**Friday night - POT LUCK** – if you wish to eat and mingle before the ride meeting, please bring a dish to share.

**Saturday Snack Shack** at the arena will be open - hamburgers, hotdogs, chips, soda, and bottled water can be purchased throughout the ride on Saturday.

**Saturday night dinner** will be provided before the awards meeting beginning around 7:00 pm. Riders meals are included; however, each additional meal will need to be specified on the registration form and will be **\$10 each**. **\*Extra meal tickets will need to be reserved and paid for in advance in order to ensure that meals are received.**

**RULES:** Junior riders (under 16 years as of the first day of the current ride season) entered in the ride will be accepted and allowed to ride only if accompanied at all times by an adult rider (21 or over). **JUNIOR RIDERS MUST WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMETS.** In order to receive credit for completing, horses must be “fit to continue” as determined by the veterinarians. Decisions of vets are final. You must present a negative Coggins test (<1 year old). All dogs must be on a leash.

**REGISTRATION & FEES:** All AERC ride applications with **deposits POST MARKED by March 2<sup>nd</sup>** will not pay a late fee. A \$30 non-refundable deposit is required with entry and all signed waivers. A \$15 fee is charged for all competition riders who are not current members of AERC.

**AWARDS:** Completion awards given to everyone who successfully finishes the ride. Additional awards given to Best Condition, First to Finish, Top Ten, Top Junior, etc...

**DIRECTIONS:** From **Columbia** head east on I-20, from **Florence** head west on I-20; once on I-20 you will take exit 123 and follow park signs on Lee State Park Road- approximately 1 mile to park entrance, then follow signs to the equestrian arena. From US HWY 15 from **Hartsville**, turn left onto Lee State Park Rd, and go approximately 3 miles to park entrance on the right. Follow signs to the equestrian arena.
