Trails: The Castle Rock Trails wind along the scenic Wisconsin River in Adams County. Although this is not hill terrain, it is a beautiful and enjoyable trail. Over 95% of the trails are two track or wider and they often wander to the shores of the Wisconsin River.

Location: Ukarydee Campground lies Southwest of Wisconsin Rapids and North of Wisconsin Dells, off Hwy Z in Adams County. Take Hwy 21 East out of Necedah and watch for turn signs. Turn on Hwy Z going South, then take Cumberland Rd. to the West. Ukarydee is down the road on your left. It is a very large campground. **NO ONE WILL BE TURNED AWAY.**

Louise Riedel Memorial Team Competition

- 1. There will be teams of 4 people (not horse and rider combinations). Teams should not be declared until Thursday, August 6, 2020.**
- 2. In order to be eligible for planning/awards, the team must enter a total of 10 events combined, though may enter as many as 12 events.** For example: 3 people enter 3 events, 1 person enter 1 event - that makes 10. 2 people enter 3 events, 2 people enter 2 events - that makes 10. 3 people enter 3 events and 1 person enters 2 events - that makes 11. 4 people enter 3 events - that makes 12.
3. A total of 10 points will be awarded for ENTERING an event. (completion is not necessary to receive the 10 points, though starting is)
4. Placings will receive the following additional points: Completion 1 point, 6th place - 2 points, 5th place - 3 points, 4th place - 4 points, 3rd place - 5 points, 2nd place - 6 points, 1st place - 7points.
5. Placing and points are based on entering the event and do not depend on mileage. (in other words, you get the same points for finishing in 2nd place on a 12 mile drive as you will placing 2nd on the 75 mile endurance ride.)
6. The plan is to have 3 sets of 4 awards each, all of equal or similar value. (i.e. 4 quilts, 4 stain glass, 4 crew bags), First place team is announced and they get to come up and each participant in that team gets to pick what they want. Second place team gets the same thing (with what's left), 3 place team will of course get what's left.

Contact your friends and acquaintances and put together a team. This is going to be fun!!
