

Trail Master Class Participant Requirements

- List the participants' names, AERC #, phone #, e-mail address, and recertification status (pg. 2).
 - * NOTE: If the participant has previously attended a trail class, please fill out a recertification form (pg. 3) for that participant. Recertification requires trails committee approval. Recertification requires at least a 3 year interval since the previous class attendance for the tuition and expenses benefit.
 - * Each participant must have been an AERC member for at least one year to receive the tuition and expenses benefit.
 - * This head count does not include the (up to) two land managers, which are completely covered by AERC.
- Obtain \$250 from each AERC participant. This covers the participant's portion of the tuition fee.
 - * In the case where you may have a low AERC turnout, but other groups/individuals have an interest, consult the Trail Master Coordinator for further details. These details are how to handle prorated instructor expenses. We are flexible and can work things out, to everyone's benefit.
