Location: Big Hill Lake, Cherryvale, Kansas

Directions: GPS and 911 address 20008 Cherryvale Parkway, Cherryvale, Kansas These directions are from highway 169, for those coming from all directions. The highway runs north and south. If coming from East or West, hit 169.

- 1. Turn EAST at SONIC (right if from South and Left if from North). The street is not marked, but it is Main Street. Pete's gas station has diesel and snacks.
- 2. Proceed 1.7 miles through downtown Cherryvale to third stop sign.
- 3. Right on Olive for .1 mile (one block or less).
- 4. Hard left on CR 5000. Go one mile. Road ends.
- 5. Hard left for 100 feet, jogging for hard right on 19000 Road. Proceed 2.4 miles
- 6. Hard left on Cherryvale Parkway (can't go right). You will see the dam.
- 7. Go 1 mile. Road ends. Hard right for .1 mile
- 8. Hard left into horse camp. Sign at entrance. Another .1 mile.

Trails: The terrain is hilly and rocky with periodic areas where you can move out. Hoof protection is recommended.

Camp: Camping is primitive and first come first served. Bathrooms and horse water available in camp. Spread manure in woods. Horses will be tied to trailer or high tie, or use portable panels

Dogs must be on leashes at all times.

Junior Riders: are those who are 15 or younger as of the first day of the new ride year (December 1, 2023) and must be accompanied by an adult sponsor throughout the ride. A helmet is also required while mounted. If the junior has no sponsor before the ride, please contact management and often a sponsor can be arranged.

Introductory Ride: The purpose of the introductory ride is to give a new rider or equine a chance to experience the sport of endurance. The equine must be at least 48 months old but there is no age limit on the rider. There will be a standard vet exam. The non AERC member fee does not apply.

Pre-Registration: You can receive a \$5 discount for pre-registration and payment by April 10, 2023.

There will be potlucks both Friday and Saturday evening. Hamburgers and hotdogs will be provided by the Sonic in Cherryvale. Bring a side to share!

RELEASE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, WAIVER, INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBYACKNOWLEDGED, AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. <u>RELEASE FROM LIABILITY</u>. I HEREBY RELEASE AND DISCHARGE THE RIDE MANAGERS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS AND PARK FROM ANY AND ALL LOSS, COSTS, DAMAGE, LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS OR CAUSES OF ACTION THAT I MAY HAVE FOR INJURIES OR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF MYPARTICIPATION IN OR OBSERVATION OF LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES.

2. <u>COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND WAIVER</u>. I AGREE THAT I WILL NOT SUE OR MAKE ANY LEGAL CLAIM AGAINST THE RIDE MANAGERS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, OR PARK FOR DAMAGES, COSTS, EXPENSES OR OTHER LOSSES, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS FEES, SUSTAINED AS A RESULT OF MY PARTICIPATION IN OR OBSERVATION OF ANY LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES, AND HEREBY VOLUNTARILY WAIVE ALL SUCH CLAIMS.

3. <u>INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS</u>. I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD THE RIDE MANAGERS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, AND PARK HARMLESS FROM ALL LOSS, DAMAGES, CLAIMS, LAWSUITS, JUDGMENTS AND COSTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ATTORNEY'S FEES, AND TO REIMBURSE FOR ANY OBLIGATIONS, COSTS AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE RIDE MANAGERS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, AND PARK IN CONNECTION WITH ANY ACTION BROUGHT AS A RESULT OF MY PARTICIPATION IN OR OBSERVATION OF LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES.

4. <u>Assumption of the Risk</u>. I know and appreciate that certain Livestock Activities are INHERENTLY DANGEROUS ACTIVITIES that can result in DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY. I understand the inherent Risks and dangers of Livestock Activities include but are not limited to the following:

- THE PROPENSITY OF LIVESTOCK TO BITE, KICK OR OTHERWISE BEHAVE IN WAYS THAT MAY RESULT IN INJURY TO PERSONS ON OR AROUND THEM;
- THE UNPREDICTABILITY OF LIVESTOCK'S REACTION TO SUCH THINGS AS SOUNDS, SUDDEN MOVEMENT AND UNFAMILIAR OBJECTS, PERSONS OR OTHER ANIMALS;
- CERTAIN HAZARDS SUCH AS SURFACE AND SUBSURFACE CONDITIONS UNKNOWN;
- COLLISIONS WITH OTHER LIVESTOCK OR OBJECTS, AND
- THE POTENTIAL OF TACK TO BECOME DISLODGED OR MOVE IN WAYS THAT MAY RESULT IN INJURY TO PERSONS ON OR AROUND LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES.

5. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR MY OWN SAFETY, AND THAT I HAVE VOLUNTARILY CHOSEN TO EXPOSE MYSELF TO THE INHERENT RISKS AND DANGERS ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN AND OBSERVATION OF LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES. IEXPRESSLY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUME THE RISK OF DEATH OR OTHER PERSONALINJURY SUSTAINED WHILE PARTICIPATING IN OR OBSERVING LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER FAULT OF THE RIDE MANAGERS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, AND PARK, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DEATH OR INJURY CAUSED BY MALFUNCTIONS, DEFECTS OR DEFICIENCIES IN EQUIPMENT OR TACK, FACILITIES OR PREMISES, OR ANY OTHER FAULT OF THE RIDE MANAGERS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, OR PARK.

6. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this Agreement will remain in full force and effect. Any provision of this Agreement held invalid or unenforceable only in part or degree will remain in full force and effect to the extent not held invalid or unenforceable.
