RIDE CHECK IN starts at 2:00 pm on Friday

DIRECTIONS: From Leavenworth - Take 73 West/Easton Road, travel Approx. 8 miles west and turn left onto KS 192, also called Easton Road. Drive through Easton, as you are leaving the town of Easton, bear left at the Y on KS 192 and go 2.6 miles to 251st Street. You will turn left (south) on 251st Street. There will be a sign and ribbons here. Ride camp is 1.25 miles south on the gravel road at the intersection with Bayles Rd.
From the West - At Hwy 59 North near Winchester, KS, take Hwy 192 East approximately 8.8 miles to 251st St. Turn right (south) onto 251st St, ride camp is 1.25 miles south on the gravel road at the intersection with Bayles Rd.

RIDE CAMP: Campground is on private property, access will **only** be available after **10** am on Friday, April 12. Campsite is primitive, with portable toilets and horse water provided at the site. Bring your own drinking water and food for your horse.

MANAGEMENT WILL PARK YOU AS CAMPING SPACE IS LIMITED.

Horse Containment: Tied to trailer or a portable pen - It is requested that pens be of a conservative size due to limited parking space. 1 horse per pen.

There is a building with heat and electric for ride meetings and potluck.

TRAILS- All Vet Checks in Camp. The Trail is flat farmland skirting planted crop land, with hills interspersed. Many of the trails are mowed 12' wide suitable for riding side by side in many places, passing is easy. Many creek crossings, water tanks placed in strategic places. Intermittent rocky spots. Hoof protection recommended, but not required.
