Fees and Submission Requirements

Please note that there is a camping fee of \$20/night as we are using a private landowners property to host the ride. Please leave your site in as good of condition as you found it as we would like to keep this ride site for future rides.

Complete ride entries submitted before May 8th, 2024. Entries received after this are subject to a late fee of \$20.

Complete registrations must include full payment by cheque or etransfer; OCTRA standard ride entry form and the following (if you register online, please scan and email the items below to the ride secretary);

- 1. Copies of 2024 OCTRA & *AERC memberships
- 2. \$1,000,000 insurance coverage
- 3. EIA negative (Coggins) test results within the previous 12 months
- 4. Proof of EHV vaccination
- 5. Proof of valid Ganaraska forest day pass or season pass

Original copies of the above to be presented when requested on site. If you are not a member of OCTRA there is a non-member fee of \$20. *AERC non-member fee of \$28 applies for LD and endurance only. Cheques are to be made payable to Sandi McCleod, eTransfers should be send to the ride secretary: octrarides@gmail.com

Emails and phone enquiries/entries are not considered complete entries. Refunds subject to \$20 admin fee with receipt of DVM or MD note if entry is withdrawn prior to competition or by submitting a DNS vet card signed by the Head Control Judge. No note, no scorecard, no show = no refund.

Extra driving directions:

Driving Instructions. *** Important as coming in from certain directions (notably north) your GPS may take you to 10 th line, it is NOT possible to access the campsite via this route with a big rig, you have to go under a small bridge which is only 11 feet high. Turn around if you end up on 10th line.

From the northeast get to County Rd 10 or County Rd 28, go south until you get to County Rd 9 (also called Ganaraska Rd). Go West on County Rd 9 until you reach Deans Hill Rd, turn right, follow to the end, turn right then a left onto Walker Rd.

From the West, if you are using the 407, get to County Rd 9 (Ganaraska Rd) you will be heading east, you are going to go left onto Hillcrest Rd, it is a small "country" road however only about 2kms and a much better turn than Deans Hill Rd which, if you are coming from the West on County Rd 9, is a tough turn for big trailers. At the end of Hillcrest turn right, then will go left onto Walker Rd.

From both West and East if you are using the 401, take the County Rd 10 (Welcome) exit, go north, turn left (west) onto Country Road 9 (Ganaraska Rd), proceed to Deans Hill Rd, turn right, at the end of Deans Hill Rd, turn right, then left onto Walker Rd.

Parking

Keep as close to your neighbour as is safe. Please be respectful of our host, Dave Walkers' property at all times.

***DO read the driving instructions as close to the property there is one road with a low bridge, and you cannot get a large trailer under it! DO not use this road, it is called 10 th line, to make matters confusing, coming from the north you will likely be on County Rd 10- this one is ok to use as it is a major road.
