

# American Endurance Ride Conference

## For Ride Managers: Entering Ride Results Online

Begin by logging in at **AERC.org** — look for the Member Home button (top right on the home page).

Now, go to the **Navigation** box and click on **Ride Manager**. This will show the rides you have sanctioned that are awaiting results. Click on **New! AERC Offline Ride Results** for the ride you wish to enter.

Select either Finish Time or Ride Time:

**Finish Time:** You can choose to set the start time and total hold times, and enter the finish time, i.e., 4:15pm (or 16:15 in military time, if you prefer).

**Ride Time:** You will enter the actual riding time, excluding holds, i.e. 5 hours and 27 minutes (05:27:00).

Click inside the Distance box and select one distance. Now you have a choice on how to proceed: adding results individually, one rider at a time, OR importing results from a pre-programmed spreadsheet.

### #1. Importing Results from a Spreadsheet

Click on the **Export** icon to download and save AERC's pre-programmed .xlsx file to enter your results. Save to your files. (We suggest saving as a template in a folder, i.e., 2025 Auburn Awesome Ride.) For every distance, be sure to fill in **ONLY** the first 5 columns: **Rider Number**,

**Member ID**, **Horse ID**, **Finish/Ride Time**, and **Finish Code**. See finish codes, next page.

If you do not have IDs for the rider or the horse (for day members and non-AERC-registered equines), then type in their names; otherwise leave those columns blank. (See above.)

Use one spreadsheet per distance.



When you've finished entering the data, click on the **Import** icon and choose the file for the distance you're uploading. (Be sure to save it as an .xlsx file.)

You'll see the data for each rider appear as a table on the webpage, and you can edit or make any changes to individual results on the page. For an explanation of the icons, see the Icons table.

## #2. Adding Results Individually

If you prefer to enter the riders' results individually, click on +Add Rider and enter data from left to right.

You'll notice that when you enter the ID numbers for horses and riders, the website will generate a dropdown menu and you can select the correct name. If the rider is not current with AERC dues you'll see the "i" turn red. If the rider has never been an AERC member, please enter their first and last name and choose their weight division manually.

Similarly, enter the equine ID and choose the correct horse from the drop down menu. If the horse is not registered with AERC, please type out the horse's name.

Next up is the ride time or finish time — enter it in the next box. Be sure to include seconds, even if it's :00. Then use the Finish Code dropdown menu to select the Finish Code (or Pull Code).

### Submitting Results for Each Distance

**SUBMIT DISTANCE / VIEW SUMMARY**

After entering the results by either method, click on the yellow Submit Distance/View Summary button to submit the results for that distance/day. You need to repeat this for each distance.

If you edit a distance of the ride results, you can submit them by clicking the yellow button again. Each time you click "submit distance," the program will overwrite the last version.

Hooray, you've successfully entered ride results in the new AERC website!

Once you're done, scroll down to the pay options. You can pay by credit or debit card online or call the AERC office with your credit card payment or send a check to AERC.
