They have a variety of camping options, and horse options. Campsites with water nearby. No primitive camping allowed. Horse options include corrals, hi-tie or stalls. If you provide East Fork Stables with coggins, signed waivers for all persons in your group and pay in full 14 days before arrival, you will receive a 10% discount off camping fees.

You MUST send a copy of current Coggins with your entry for admission to ride camp. EFS rules.

NO MEALS: No meals are provided. There will be several food trucks on-site. See our Facebook group for more information.

The trails at East Fork has a variety of terrain: along the rim is rolling, with excellent footing. There are wide cart trails

that are relatively flat also with excellent footing. Then there are steep mountain climbs with some rocks. Each loop will

have a different character. Hoof protection is advised.

The weather in early May average high 70s for the highs and around 50 for the lows. There are ample natural water sources on trail and there will be troughs at select spots.

VET-IN/START: Head vet: Dr. Ken Marcella; Treatment vet: Dr. Melissa Hines.

Vet in begins ~2 PM CDT Thursday for Friday's ride and worked in between riders on Friday afternoon for Saturday's ride. No vetting in after dark. Please plan accordingly. Ride briefings on Thursday and Friday evenings followed by a New Rider Briefing. Awards on Friday and Saturday evenings. Start for the 50 mile ride will be after daylight; the 25

mile riders and Intro riders will leave after that. A full schedule will be posted at registration.

AWARDS: Completion awards to all who finish meeting ride criteria and following all ride rules. Top 10 awards for the 50 mile

riders; Top 10 awards for the 25 mile riders; Top Juniors for both distances. Best condition for all distances.

NO RUNNING IN CAMP RULE

Equines are not permitted to trot, canter, gait, lope or otherwise go faster than a walk while in camp, unless at the direction of a ride vet or inside the arena. This applies to equines mounted or in-hand. Doing so will **RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.**

Spin Around the Rim Ride Management will enforce this rule by disqualifying any rider whose equine is observed going faster than a walk inside the bounds of the campground. Signs will be posted reminding riders of this rule, but the lack of signs does not absolve the rider of following this rule.

This rule is in effect regardless of whether you started or finished the event. It will remain in effect whenever you are in camp on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

This is a rule for the safety of all riders, volunteers and East Fork Stables staff and visitors. It will be strictly and unapologetically enforced. Argument may result in being uninvited to future events put on by ride management.

You may use the arena for faster work or trot your equine out when/where instructed by a Spin Around the Rim ride vet. We put this rule in place under AERC Rule:

- 6. Completion requires meeting all the following criteria.
- j. Meeting any other criteria prescribed by ride management.

Please also see AERC Rule 12 regarding appropriate behavior of AERC riders at a venue.

The Undersigned, in consideration of acceptance of his/her entry in this ride, does hereby for himself/herself, his/her heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release all ride personnel and the sanctioning Ride Organizations, their officers, and all individual members thereof, and all other persons, regardless of their capacity, in any way connected with this event, their representatives, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns for any and all right, claim or liability of any kind or nature the Undersigned might have. Further, the Undersigned does hereby acknowledge that said release will extend to any accidents, damages or claims arising out of his/her entry caused by his/her own acts or anyone or any animal within his/her control.
