Refunds: 100% Refunds will be given for rider cancellations prior to June 1st. 50% Refunds will be given to riders after June 1st through June 10th. No refunds will be given after June 10th; no exceptions. *Force Majeure: In the event that there is a Force Majeure, act of God, or closure by the US Corps of Engineers and the event must be cancelled, the Ride will refund all but \$25 to cover non-recoverable ride expenses.*

- Intro/25/50 Mile Ride Entry Fee: \$95
- Dry Camping: \$40
- Electric Hook-up with 2 permanent pens: \$60

Awards: All riders who complete the course will receive a decal with the ride logo.

Trails: Tokens/Spotters/Game Cameras will be used to ensure riders correctly follow trail. Trail will be repetitive and marked with LED lights. Headlamps are permissible and recommended (no lumen maximum). Please be respectful when riding with a headlamp and do not shine light in a horse or riders face/eyes.

Meals: Ride Management will provide lunch (hamburgers, chips, and salad) at 12PM on June 14th to all attendees, crew, volunteers, and staff. Coffee and assorted beverages will be available to everyone all weekend as well. There will not be a food truck on-site.

Camping: Ride Camp opens June 13th at 8AM and closes on June 16th at 8AM. If you need to arrive sooner, or depart later, please contact Ride Management for assistance. There will be 6 electric hook-up spots available; each hook-up site comes with 2 permanent covered pens. There are 25 dry camping spots available. There will be no “day use” parking. ALL trailers must have an assigned and paid for camping spot. If you’re carpooling with another rider, your horse will have to come in their trailer and use their camping spot. 


