The Big South Fork National River and Recreation Area is a 120,000-acre park, which straddles the Tennessee-Kentucky line 80 miles northwest of Knoxville. This woodland plateau has been sculpted into rugged rocky bluffs and deep gorges all within huge forested areas with hundreds of miles of trails.

Trail

Trails are well maintained, being mostly wooded, consisting of dirt, sand and gravel footing. There are old logging roads with a mixture of easy, fast stretches, rolling slower areas, hill climbs and rocky sandstone sections. **We HIGHLY recommend hoof protection so please shoe/pad or boot according to your horse's needs.**

<u>Camp</u>

- Camp is a primitive grassy field just past the Bandy Creek complex
- Most camping is in the right field, largest rigs are in the left field
- Hydrant for horse or people water and bathrooms with running water 0.3 miles from camp
- Port-a-johns will be on site
- Bathhouses at the Bandy Creek Campground 0.8 miles from camp and can be used for a small fee

Rules

- Approved safety helmets are REOUIRED for ALL riders when mounted at any time, in camp or on trail
- All AERC and SERA rules apply
- Decisions of vets are final
- **All dogs** must be on a leash (park rule)
- Generators off at 10:00 pm

Directions

Do **NOT** approach the ride, the Bandy Creek area, through Oneida. Come in from the west on 297, Leatherwood Rd from the Jamestown side. **Avoid** crossing the Big South Fork Cumberland River due to the steep switchbacks in the gorge. Come in from the north or south on hwy 127, taking 154 Pickett Park hwy for 8.2 miles. Right on 297 for 10 miles. Left onto Bandy Creek Rd for 2 miles. As the road turns to gravel, camp is on the left and right side of the road.
