<u>Pre-Entry and prepayment are strongly encouraged.</u> Failure to pre-enter and prepay will result in forfeiture of additional awards for completion, and any meals provided by Ride Management. An additional fee will be charged for entries AFTER October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2025.

**Refunds:** Riders who cancel on or before October 3rd will receive a full refund minus a \$25 administrative fee. Cancellations between October 4th and October 10th will receive a 50% refund. No refunds will be issued after October 10th—no exceptions. Force Majeure: In the event that there is a Force Majeure, act of God, or closure by the Land Heritage Institute and the event must be cancelled, the Ride will refund all but \$25 to cover non-recoverable ride expenses.

Trails: The Land Heritage Institute is a 1,200-acre "living land museum" south of San Antonio, featuring about 20 miles of multi-use dirt trails winding through shady oak and pecan groves, open grasslands, and scenic river basins along the Medina River. Designed primarily for horseback use, the wide, gently rolling trails are also popular with hikers and mountain bikers—just remember to yield to riders and cross carefully where these trails meet the paved Medina River Greenway. Along the way you'll pass historic markers, old farmstead structures, and even a herd of authentic longhorn cattle—making it a unique blend of natural beauty, equestrian fun, and Texas heritage. Ride Management believes these trails are barefoot friendly, but please have another option prepared if you decide your horse needs hoof protection.

<u>Meals:</u> Ride Management will provide dinner on Friday evening (10/17) for all riders, volunteers, and staff. Additional meals for crew and spectators can be purchased in advance through the JotForm.

Ride management plans to have a food truck on-site for Thursday lunch/dinner and all-day Friday and Saturday. Please check the Facebook page for updates regarding a food truck and menu options.

Manure & Trash Disposal: Three manure dump stations are available at base camp. Please use the provided wheelbarrows and manure forks to clean up all manure and excess hay before you leave. We're incredibly fortunate to enjoy this beautiful property, so let's all do our part to keep it clean. Trash bins are located throughout camp—be sure to dispose of all trash properly and leave no trace! If you prefer not to handle manure cleanup at your campsite, Marcus is available to scoop manure for \$15/day/horse or \$40 for the weekend/horse. You can contact him at 210-573-0595 to arrange services.

<u>Camping:</u> Ride Camp opens October 15<sup>th</sup> at Noon and closes on October 19<sup>th</sup> at Noon. If you need to arrive sooner, or depart later, please contact Ride Management for assistance.

**Alcohol Use:** Alcohol is permitted on the premises but must be consumed discreetly—either inside personal vehicles or campers, or in a generic cup so it is not visible to the public.
