Vet in begins at 4p Thursday for Fridays ride and 4p Friday for Saturdays ride; Ride will begin at dawn both days.

AWARDS: Completion awards to all who finish any distance meeting ride criteria and following all ride rules. Top 10

awards in the 50 Endurance and the 25 Limited Distance; Top Juniors for both distances. Best condition for

both distances.

DIRECTIONS: From I-65 take Exit 19. Turn west on SR 160. Go approximately 5.5 miles and turn left onto Pixley Knob Road

for 1.4 miles. Then turn right onto Flatwood Road for 1.4 miles and camp will be on your right.

The Undersigned acknowledges that distance horseback riding is a sport which carries an inherent risk, which means a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following: (a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine; (b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movements, unfamiliar objects, persons, motorized vehicles, or other animals; (c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant. (f) All participants will hold harmless the ride management and all persons attending this event harmless for any illness that occurs due to attending this event. You are responsible for your own health!

The Undersigned, in consideration of acceptance of his/her entry in this ride, does hereby for himself/herself, his/her heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release all ride personnel and the sanctioning Ride Organizations, their officers, and all individual members thereof, and all other persons, regardless of their capacity, in any way connected with this event, their representatives, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns for any and all right, claim or liability of any kind or nature the Undersigned might have.
