Directions

Head to Belton, Texas. If coming from the north or south on I35 you will turn West on I14 headed towards Killeen for 17 Miles. In Killeen you will go South on Hwy 195 for about 9 miles. **Do Not Take Maxdale Road off of 201.**

GPS may insist you go that way- but it is through the Military Base, its non paved and lots of ruts. You will regret going that way. After following Hwy 195 for 9 miles you will turn onto 2670. Head West on 2670 for 3.4 miles, then turn right onto Maxdale Road. Ranch Sign will be about 2.4 miles on the left. Signs will be up for the ride as well.

TRAILS: Parrie Haynes Ranch Equestrian Center is settled along the Lampasas River on about 1600 acres of Hill Country terrain on the east side and about 2k on the west side. West Fort Hood borders our northern side. The acreage is teeming with natural wildlife and native plants with trails that wind through rolling native prairies, pastures, cedar/oak trees, and crystal clear streams. The Priddy Cabin was built here in 1859. Other homes were scattered across the ranch and have only foundations remaining. The main camp is about 24 acres out of 1600.

Currently, there are 40 complete sites with 30 & 50 amp electricity, water, and pens at individual sites! We have 86 pens and a few corrals. There is a half size arena, round pen, and a fun obstacle course for you and your equine to enjoy. The footing is a combination of sand, caleche, and rock. Boots or shoes are highly recommended. There are plenty of places to move out but there is a lot of rock. For 50 milers pads may be a good idea.

RULES: Endurance is an athletic event for both horse and rider. The goal is to complete the marked trail within the time given as established by AERC standards with an equine that is fit to continue from checkpoint to checkpoint. Equines must pass a complete vet check before, during, and after the ride. All AERC rules will apply. Safety helmets are recommended for all riders, but are required for juniors at any time they are on their equine, in camp or on trail. Junior riders must be accompanied by a designated adult sponsor (21 years or older) at all times during the ride. Juniors riding as Seniors must show AERC approval.

GATE HOURS: Camp will open on Friday at 10:00am, and close Monday at 10:00 am. Water for horse and human is available in camp. Vet checks will be in camp.

CAMPING: Trail access is private. No riding on the trails on ride days unless you are entered in the ride. You may pay the Parrie Haynes Daily fee to ride the day before the ride if you so wish. Generators off at 10 pm, on at 5:30 am. No All night generator area per the campground rules. Hookups are available to reserve if you need power. Call Parrie Haynes to reserve!

Weather: January in Texas can be anything from cool (highs in the 70's) to cold (highs in the 40's). Come prepared for just about anything!! Ride venue handles water fairly well, so ride will go on unless there is a flood the week of. Please ignore any people talking about cancellation unless it comes from myself!! (Kerry Lowrey)
