Primitive camping only, no electrical hookups. Horses may be housed at camp - **A limited number of stalls and paddocks are available for an additional fee of \$30 per night, 2 night minimum. STALLS ARE NOT RESERVED UNTIL PAID FOR.** 2 Bags of shavings provided per stall. Refund on Stalls ONLY if we are able to fill them from a waitlist. Campfires are only permitted in a metal, outdoor fire pit. In accordance with Shaker Village's liquor license, visitors to the Village are prohibited from consuming alcoholic beverages in public unless purchased from Shaker Village. Horse water will be available. **Current coggins required for entry to Shaker Village. All riders must arrive before 8 p.m.-due to safety and visibility- daylight driving on the property only.** If you plan to arrive on Wednesday, May 7, 2026 please contact Shaker Village at (859) 734-5411 arrangements can be made for you. Early arrival fee of \$10.00 must be paid to Shaker Village. You can pay this fee upon check in.

VET-IN/START: Head Vet, Robert Marshall, DVM

Vet-in begins at 4pm. Thursday for Friday's ride and 4pm Friday for Saturday's ride. The 50 mile ride will begin at 7:00am. each day. The 25 mile ride will begin at 8:00a.m. All vet checks will be at the camp in the West Lot.

TRAILS: Will be primarily over rolling hills in open pasture, and will border historic rock fences. There will be a few creek crossings with plenty of rocks and minimal gravel. However, pads are not recommended. A trail fee of \$15 must be included for each day you plan to ride on the trails. Shaker Village annual pass holders do not have to pay the fee if the pass is current. Please bring your annual pass to ride.

LOCATION: Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill, Kentucky. 3501 Lexington Road, Harrodsburg KY 40330. Shaker Village is located at the caution light on U.S. 68, at the intersection of KY Route 33. The entrance to Shaker Village is six miles east of the intersection of U.S. 127, Harrodsburg bypass and U.S. 68. After turning into Shaker Village, turn left at the guard house, drive past the pond and keep driving on the blacktop road to the bottom of the hill. Turn right at the bottom of the hill to West Lot, about a 1/2 mile. *It is not recommended that you take U.S. 68 from Lexington to Shaker Village due to the tight turns going down to and up from the Kentucky River.*

ENTRY FEES/REFUNDS: MUST PRE-ENTER & PRE-PAY. Late fee of \$35 applied if you register onsite OR after the deadline of May 1, 2026 OR not paid in full. Cancellations will be refunded less a \$50 administration fee. 100% refund only if your horse doesn't vet through at the ride. No Refunds after vet in.

RELEASE OF LEGAL LIABILITY

Please read the Kentucky Equine Liability Law, the release and then sign.

KRS 247.4027: Under Kentucky law, a farm animal activity sponsor, farm animal professional, or other person does not have the duty to eliminate all risks of injury of participation in farm animal activities. There are inherent risks of injury that you voluntarily accept if you participate in farm animal activities.

I wish to enter and participate in the Shake It Up Endurance Ride to be held at Shaker Village at Pleasant Hill, 3501 Lexington Road, Harrodsburg, Kentucky. The dates I may participate are May 9th-10th, 2026. As a participant in the Shake It Up endurance ride, I agree to abide by the rules of AERC, and ride management. I understand that endurance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards, which ride management, cannot anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate; that horses (equines) are excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable; that accidents can happen to anyone at any time. I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the equine I am riding/handling. I will hold ride Daniel Boone Distance Riders, LLC, American Endurance Ride Conference, ride management, all ride personnel and volunteers, all veterinarians and Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill, Harrodsburg, Kentucky, and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses blameless for any accident, injury or loss that might occur due to my participating in the ride, and free from all liability for such injury or loss. This release extends to all claims of every kind and nature whatsoever, whether known or unknown, and I expressly waive any benefits that I may otherwise have under provisions of the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky relating to the release of unknown claims. I understand that this release constitutes a limitation of my legal rights.

DIRECTIONS

FROM TENNESSEE I-75, TRAVELING NORTH

Exit I-75 at the Mt Vernon exit, which is U.S. 150. Travel west on U.S. 150 through Mt. Vernon, Brodhead, Crab Orchard and Stanford. 10 miles from Stanford, continue on U.S. 150 bypass around Danville. At the intersection of U.S. 127, (Danville Manor Shopping Center on right) the bypass becomes U.S. 150 and U.S. 127 bypass. Continue on U.S. 127 to Harrodsburg. Do not leave U.S. 127 when U.S. 150 turns left (west) to Perryville or turns right to downtown Danville.

McDonalds is on left side of the intersection and Boyle County High School on right. Continue straight for 8 miles to U.S. 127 bypass outside of Harrodsburg. Turn right onto U.S. 127 bypass (north) at stoplight. Travel 2.8 miles on bypass to intersection of U.S. 68. (second stop light)

Turn right onto U.S. 68 east Travel 6 miles on U.S. 68 to caution light at top of hill. Turn left into Shaker Village.

FROM TENNESSEE I-65, TRAVELING NORTH

Exit I-65 about 30 miles north of Bowling Green onto Cumberland Parkway (East) Take Cumberland Parkway to the U.S. 127 exit Take U.S. 127 north through Jamestown, Liberty, and Junction City. At Junction City, U.S. 127 changes to 4 lanes. Travel 3 miles on the 4 lane, to the Wal Mart Super Center on the right. Just past Wal Mart is the intersection of U.S. 127 and U.S. 150. Turn left onto U.S. 127 bypass, (north) around Danville, Kentucky. Travel 10 miles on U.S. 127 to the U.S. 127 bypass outside of Harrodsburg, Kentucky.

Turn right onto U.S. 127 bypass (north) at stoplight. Travel 2.8 miles on bypass to intersection of U.S. 68. (second stop light)

Turn right onto U.S. 68 east Travel 6 miles on U.S. 68 to caution light at top of hill. Turn left into Shaker Village.

FROM OHIO I-75, TRAVELING SOUTH

Exit I-75 at the Lexington, Newtown Pike (Airport) exit 115. Turn right at bottom of ramp onto Newtown Pike. Drive 1.7 miles (follow signs to airport) After traveling past stop light at bottom of hill, turn right off of Newtown Pike onto Kentucky Route 4, west (New Circle Road) Travel 4.2 miles on Ky 4. Turn right at exit 5B, onto U.S. 60 (Versailles Rd), to Airport & Keeneland. Travel 5.8 miles on Versailles Road. Just past stop light at

Marathon gas station, turn right onto Bluegrass Parkway to Lawrenceburg and Elizabethtown.

After crossing the Kentucky River, exit the Bluegrass Parkway at exit 59A, to Harrodsburg and Danville. You will take U.S. 127 South towards Harrodsburg for 13 miles, and turn left at the stoplight for the U.S. 127 bypass.

Travel 1.5 miles on U.S. 127 bypass to the first stop light, which is U.S. 68. Turn left on U.S. 68 (east) Travel 6 miles to caution light at top of hill. Turn left into Shaker Village.

FROM ASHLAND, KY I-64 TRAVELING WEST

Turn right, onto I-75 (North) at the junction of I-64 and I-75. Take I-75 north to exit 115, Newtown Pike, Airport Exit. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto Newtown Pike. Turn left at bottom of ramp onto Newtown Pike. Drive 1.7 miles (follow signs to airport) After traveling past stop light at bottom of hill, turn right off of Newtown Pike onto Kentucky Route 4, west (New Circle Road) Travel 4.2 miles on Ky 4. Turn right at exit 5B, onto U.S. 60 (Versailles Rd), to Airport & Keeneland.

Travel 5.8 miles on Versailles Road. Just past stop light at Chevron station, turn right onto Bluegrass Parkway to Lawrenceburg and Elizabethtown. After crossing the Kentucky River, exit the Bluegrass Parkway at exit 59A, to Harrodsburg and Danville. You will take U.S. 127 South towards Harrodsburg for 13 miles, and turn left at the stoplight for the U.S. 127 bypass. Travel 1.5 miles on U.S. 127 bypass to the first stop light, which is U.S. 68. Turn left on U.S. 68 (east) Travel 6 miles to caution light at top of hill. Turn left into Shaker Village.

FROM LOUISVILLE I-64 TRAVELING EAST

Take exit 48 at Waddy, Ky. Turn right at bottom of ramp onto KY route 151. About 4 miles to stoplight of intersection with U.S. 127. Turn right on U.S. 127 (south) to Lawrenceburg. From Lawrenceburg main intersection, high school & McDonalds on left, continue on U.S. 127 for 4 miles and pass over Bluegrass Parkway. From Bluegrass Parkway continue on U.S. 127 for 13 miles to stoplight at U.S. 127 bypass. (Just past park on left) Turn left onto U.S. 127 bypass (south) Travel 1.5 miles on U.S. 127 bypass to the first stop light, which is U.S. 68. Turn left on U.S. 68 (east) Travel 6 miles to caution light at top of hill. Turn left into Shaker Village.
