The name of the ride refers to the affectionate nickname given to Chiropractors many years ago. This is not a reference to the actual ride terrain and should not be frightening!!

South Kettle Moraine Horseman's Park - Palmyra, WI

All rides will begin around Dawn, please attend riders meeting the night prior to each ride for detailed instructions.

Friday: 50 End, 25 LD, 25 CTR, 25 Drive (9 AM), 12 Novice (noon)

Saturday: 75 End, 55 End, 35 LD, 35 CTR, 12 Intro (noon), 25 LD (4:30 PM)

Sunday: 50 End, 25 LD, 25 CTR*

*MUST have ten prepaid entries by potluck on Saturday, or the rides may not be held.

Trails: The South Kettle Moraine Park in beautiful Wisconsin has rolling hills, meadows and trees. There are ample places for crewing, as there are several road crossings, but there are no water crossings. The weather will most likely be hot and humid, with a chance of rain very likely. Water will be readily available on trail at numerous locations. Hoof protection is recommended, as some portions of the trail are quite rocky.

Directions: Off Main Street in Palmyra, turn Southeast at the True Value Hardware store on South 3rd St. Horseman's camp is on the left. <https://wisconsin.goingtocamp.com> to purchase a campsite. The WI DNR requires all adult riders to purchase a trail pass, and a vehicle registration. We will not turn people away but finding a camp site prior to attending is highly recommended.
