## RIDE DETAILS AND INFORMATION

**NOTE: a current negative Coggins is required to be presented at time of arrival to Base Camp. Additionally, a veterinary issued health certificate is required for all horses being transported from out of state. NO EXCEPTIONS!** [USDA APHIS (<https://www.aphis.usda.gov>) and the Texas Animal Health Commission (tahc.texas.gov): Texas requires that horses traveling between states for events be accompanied by a **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)** and proof of a current (within one year) negative **Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) test.**]

**CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:** Cancellations made prior to 5:00pm 27 April 2026 will receive a full refund. Cancellations received between 5:00pm 27 April 2026 and midnight 30 April 2027 will be charged a \$25 administration fee. If a horse does not pass initial Vet check on the day before the ride as determined by the ride Vet, they will receive a full refund. A no show-no call will not receive a refund. Once a rider starts the ride, the entry fee is non-refundable. Ride Manager must be notified of cancellation by the start of the ride or no refund will be issued. Please allow 7-10 business days after the ride for receipt of refund.

**RIDE MEETING and MEALS:** The Ride Meeting will be held immediately following the Friday evening pot-luck (meal to begin approximately 6:00pm). Saturday evening meal will be provided by Management and will begin at approximately 6:00pm. Saturday evening meal is free for riders; \$10 each for non-riders (add to entry form)

**TRAIL:** The trail will be clearly marked with flags. Levees should only be ridden on in emergency situations. River bottom should only be used for crossing under bridges. The majority of the ride will take place in open flood plain.

**VET CHECKS:** All Vet Checks will take place at Base Camp. Pre-ride vetting will start at approximately 2:00pm on Friday, 1 May 2026. There will be 1 (one) vet check for the 25 and 50-mile rides. There will be a 1 hour hold at each vet check. The 50-mile ride will have 1 pulse & go.

**BASE CAMP:** Located at 6627 N Strahan Road. You may arrive on Friday, 1 May 2026, no earlier than 9:00am. Trailer parking available. No water, electricity or sewer hook-ups available. There will be water available for horses. **NO OPEN FLAMES!** **Directions to Base Camp:** Take Transmountain exit off I-10; west to Spur 16; to Doniphan; turn south on Doniphan to Borderland; turn west on Borderland to N Strahan; turn north on Strahan; 9/10 of a mile to 6627 N Strahan Road. Enter through marked open gate. (Please follow these directions as Google may misdirect)

### **GENERAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS:**

- **Current negative Coggins will be required for all horses; A current health certificate will be required for horses arriving from out of state.** No exceptions. These items will be checked on Friday, 1 May 2026, upon arrival to Base Camp by event personnel. If these items are not available for review at that time, horse and rider will be asked to vacate the Base Camp.
- This ride will be conducted in accordance with AERC ([www.aerc.org](http://www.aerc.org))
- All junior riders must wear a helmet at all times while on an equine and must ride with an adult sponsor.
- All dogs must be controlled AND on a leash. No dogs are allowed on the trail or vet area.
- All trash must be cleaned up and hauled out. Hay and manure can be spread.
- Discourteous or unsportsmanlike behavior by rider or crew, including abusive treatment of animals or ride personnel will result in immediate disqualification.
- To qualify for completion, the same horse and rider combination must pass all control points and stay on marked trails.

I will hold AERC, the International Boundary and Water Commission, ride management, all ride personnel, and all property owners over whose land the ride passes blameless for any accident, injury or loss that might occur due to my participation in this event; and free from all liability for such injury or loss. Junior riders (under 16 years of age as of the first day of the current ride season) entered in the ride will be accepted and allowed to ride only if accompanied by an adult rider (21 or over). Junior riders will not be allowed to start or continue on from any point without an adult sponsor. **JUNIOR RIDERS MUST WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMETS.** We will not be held responsible for any communicable disease that might be encountered at this ride. **I HAVE READ THE RULES, CONDITIONS AND REGULATION OF THIS RIDE AND WILL ABIDE BY THEM. PARENT/GUARDIAN SIGNATURE GIVES PERMISSION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT OF JUNIOR.**
