Endurance Ride 25/50/75/100



September 4, 5 and 6, 2026

Three glorious days of riding in the breathtaking mountains of the beautiful Boise Basin, where gold was discovered in 1862, and beautiful treasures are still found today!

Day 1 – Friday September 4, 25-mile LD and 50-mile Endurance rides

Day 2 – Saturday September 5, 25-mile LD and 50-mile Endurance rides

Day 3 – Sunday September 6, 25-mile LD and 50-, 75-and 100-mile Endurance rides

Introductory Trail Ride each day

Directions: From I-84 in Boise take Hwy 21 NE 36 miles to Idaho City. Turn Left (north) onto Montgomery St. At the end of the street, turn left (west) and continue for 7 miles (dirt road between towns) to Centerville. Turn right (north) onto Henry's creek Rd. and continue approx. ½ mile into camp. **Note: we do NOT recommend traveling up Grimes Creek!**

Camp: Ride camp is on private property, but it borders Forest Service land so **weed free hay is required**. Horse water will be supplied but bring people water. Dogs are welcome but must be leashed at all times and kept out of the vet area. GPS Coordinates: Latitude: 43.88627 Longitude: -115.90513.

Fees: 25- and 50-Mile rides \$145, 75 Mile ride \$190, 100 Mile ride \$250. Current year/reciprocating ride managers 50% discount (one day only; other days at full price). Intro Rides \$35 per day. Non-AERC members will be subject to an additional \$20 per day non-member fee for competitive distances.

Pay at the ride: cash or checks only

JUNIORS (under age 18 as of 1/1/26) ride FREE

Start Times: 50-mile rides @ 6:30 a.m.; LDs @ 7 a.m., 75 and 100 milers @ 5:30 a.m. Intro ride any time after 9 a.m. but no later than 3 p.m. (trail riders must check in and out with ride management).

Trails: Trails are primarily old logging roads, ATV and single-track trails on private property, US Forest Service, and Idaho State Lands. The terrain is rolling, with mostly nice, sandy footing, but there are water crossings and rocky sections through dredged creek banks. **Hoof Protection is STRONGLY recommended.**

Food: Food will be available to purchase from XG-Smokehouse throughout the weekend.

Schedule: Check-in and vetting starts approximately 4 p.m. on Thursday September 3.
Pre-ride meeting at approx. 7 p.m.

Old Selam Intro Ride for Trail Riders

SEPTEMBER 4, 5 and 6, 2026

Southwest Idaho Trail and Distance Riders invite you to enjoy noncompetitive introductory trail rides Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of Labor Day weekend, concurrent with our competitive endurance rides. Ride at your own pace on our marked trails. Scenic loops take you through this historic mining area on trails ranging in length from 8 to 15 miles (your choice). After vetting your horse with one of our on-site veterinarians, you may leave any time between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Join us for the day or camp overnight and enjoy beautiful trails that cross across private, state, and National Forest land.

WEED FREE HAY required. Horse water available in camp and on the trail, with some natural stream crossings. Bring your own potable water.

WHERE: Boise Basin, New Centerville. Ride Camp is approximately 9 miles northwest from Idaho City via Centerville Road. From I-84 in Boise take Hwy 21 NE 36 miles to Idaho City. Turn left (north) onto Montgomery Street. At the end of the street, turn left (west) and continue for 9 miles to New Centerville. Turn right (north) onto Henry's Creek Road and continue approximately one-half mile into camp. (NOTE: Under no circumstances do we recommend traveling up Grimes Creek Road, it is AWFUL!)

GPS Coordinates: Latitude: 43.88627 Longitude: -115.90513

HOOF PROTECTION STRONGLY RECOMMENDED! Trails are on old logging roads, ATV trails, and single-track trails. Most trails offer soft forest footing, but some sections have rocks.

WHEN: Friday, Saturday and Sunday, September 4, 5 and 6, 2026

INTRO RIDE FEE: \$35.00 per day (cash or check only)

NOTE: XG Smokehouse will be on-site to provide sandwiches for purchase
